## AWE AND WONDER

The **Reflection Room** is a unique space in Felixstowe School for students to contemplate, pray and reflect. We are fortunate to be able to use this space for our chaplaincy and pastoral support. Throughout the year we delivered **assemblies** to all year groups at the high school around Christmas, Easter, Holocaust Memorial Day and Remembrance, as well as **Celebration Assemblies** at the end of each term.



## JUSTICE AND ACTIVISM

Chaplaincy is all about championing children and young people, whether through everyday interactions on the playground at Colneis, or supporting **Student Parliament** at Felixstowe School to help improve the school experience. **The Garden Project** at Felixstowe School is  $\frac{1}{3}$  of an acre of land which we are transforming into a beautiful place for food growing, environmental activism and nature connection.



## WHOLENESS & INCLUSION

At Colneis, Julie provides support for individuals, through **mentoring**, small group support for **Young Carers** as well as being **available** to all students and staff. At Felixstowe School, since September Josh has delivered **134** one-to-one sessions with **66** students. This includes **mentoring**, support for those who have experienced a **bereavement**, and our unique behavioural **intervention** programme called SWITCH. Our resources are being used by other schools and St Elizabeth's Hospice to support even more young people.
